## **I. CALL TO ORDER**

President Allen called the meeting to order at 10:00 a.m.

## **II. ROLL CALL AND MINUTES**

Todd Olson took the roll and President Allen declared a quorum. President Allen asked if anyone had any deletions, omissions, or modifications to the minutes of the first quarter 2001 Board of Director's meeting. A motion was made to accept the minutes for the first quarter 2001 Board of Directors' Meeting and it passed unanimously.

## **III. CORRESPONDENCE**

Several pieces of correspondence were discussed.

The first correspondence was an email from Nancy Allen to FAPMS officers and directors regarding a vote concerning a FAPMS sponsorship of 2 IFAS photomurals for \$3,000 and a vote concerning the 2001 FAPMS Annual Meeting site. The second correspondence was an email from Nancy Allen to FAPMS officers and directors with the results of the vote for the IFAS photomurals and the vote for the 2001 FAPMS Annual Meeting site. The board approved the IFAS photomural sponsorship and chose the Adam's Mark Hotel and Resort as the 2001 FAPMS Annual Meeting site

## **IV. TREASURER'S REPORT – Steve Weinsier**

Steve reported that his draft balance sheet ending March 31, 2001 showed that the Society's current assets were \$47,024.92 and liabilities at \$0.00. A breakdown of the total assets included a Nations Bank checking balance of \$15,252.22, and a Nations Bank savings account balance of \$5,795.52, Nations Bank CD account balance of approximately \$10,066.63 and \$12,674.96 in the Strong Money Market Fund. Steve presented the board members the FAPMS 2000 tax forms and cover letter by our C.P.A.

## **V. SECRETARY'S REPORT – Todd Olson**

Todd had no report.

## **VI. EDITOR'S REPORT – Judy Ludlow**

No report was given. David Farr made a motion to accept the treasurer's, secretary's and editor's reports. It received a second by John Rodgers and passed unanimously.

## **VII. COMMITTEE REPORTS**

### **1. Advisory –**

No report was given.

### **2. Auditing – Rebecca Gubert**

Rebecca had no report.

### **3. Awards – Nick Schooley**

Nick reported that he just received some material and would arrange a committee meeting.

### **4. By-Laws – Stephanie McCarty**

Stephanie had no report.

### **5. Financial – Nancy Allen**

President Allen reported that the Financial Committee voted to spend up to \$200 for the refreshments at the second quarter board meeting at the Adam's Mark, Daytona Beach.

#### **6. Government Affairs – Keshav Setaram**

Jeff Schardt summarized a pending lawsuit in the Ninth Circuit Court of Appeals (Northwest United States) which involves a canal herbicide application that was allowed to go downstream causing a fish kill. The Court held in *Headwaters, Inc. v. Talent Irrigation District* that an irrigation district in Oregon was required to obtain a National Pollution Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit under the Clean Water Act before applying an aquatic herbicide in its canals. Talent Irrigation District has requested a reconsideration by the court. Apparently the court ruling only applies to the ninth circuit. USEPA is examining the legal/regulatory situation and will be involved in its resolution. The APMS is monitoring the case for potential ramifications outside the ninth circuit.

A motion was passed to send a letter from FAPMS to Florida's congressional delegation in support of funding the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers Aquatic Plant Control cost share program. A copy of the letter will be sent to APMS president Jim Schmidt.

#### **7. Historical – Catherine Johnson**

Nancy reported for Catherine that they continue to archive the society by 1) contacting past presidents for photos and items from their administration. Photos are needed from 1980-1990, 2) continue installments in "Aquatics" magazines 3) prepare a short history for the website. The final draft of the membership brochure should be available soon for final comments.

#### **8. Local Arrangements – David Farr**

David reported the site for primary consideration for 2002 FAPMS Annual Meeting is the Amtel (formerly Sheraton) in Fort Myers. David will visit the Amtel in Fort Myers and report back to the board. David will have a list of hotels to consider for the 2003 annual meeting by the next board meeting. Nancy asked about security at the Adam's Mark and David said the hotel usually pays close attention to the lot during events.

#### **9. Mailing List – Jackie Smith**

No report was given.

#### **10. Merchandising – Jeff Holland**

Jeff reported that he received some examples of potential commemorative items for the 25th anniversary of the FAPMS. The board looked at the items and Bill Moore made a motion to have coffee mugs with the FAPMS logo in silver as the commemorative items. The motion received a second by David Sutton and passed 6-3 and will be handed out during registration at the 2001 FAPMS Annual Meeting.

#### **11. Nominating – Jeff Schardt**

Jeff mentioned he would have a slate of candidates for the board to consider at the next board meeting

#### **12. Past President's Advisory – Jeff Schardt**

Jeff had no report to give.

#### **13. Program – Vicki Pontius and Bruce Burley**

Vicki reported that they had a committee meeting to start arranging the program. The committee discussed implementing a new system for signing off for CEU's at the annual meeting. The final call for papers will be in the next newsletter.

#### **14. Publicity – John Rodgers**

John presented the new web domain name for the society. It is . and should be working shortly. John discussed some alternatives which included using the old booth or implementing new poster boards which could be cheaper, easier to move and could be stored in different regions of the state for educational purposes. John will bring examples and prices to the next board meeting. Jeff reported that he was working in conjunction with APMS and David Tarver to produce educational material to be distributed to grade school kids through the Sea Grant program. APMS will likely ask FAPMS to help support this educational effort at the next board meeting.

#### **15. Resource Demonstration – Christine Bauer**

Christine reported progress on several potential demonstration ideas. Some possibilities are: Plant I.D., Insect Vectors, GIS, and the FAPMS web page

#### **16. Scholarship – Brian Nelson**

No report was given.

### 17. Vendor – Lonnie Pell

Todd reported for Lonnie that he would have one or two golf courses picked out before the next board meeting for discussion and approval.

### VIII. OLD BUSINESS

President Allen mentioned a letter from AERF requesting FAPMS to join their foundation for \$250.00 per year. President Allen read the basic concepts of the AERF to the board and asked if anyone would like to make a motion to join at \$250 per year. Jeff Schardt made a motion to join AERF and it received a second from PJ Myers. The motion passed unanimously.

### IX. NEW BUSINESS

President Allen opened discussion about registration fees for the 2001 FAPMS Annual Meeting. Last years fees were \$35 pre-registered; \$40 at the door. David Farr mentioned that the costs of the breaks and banquet would be 15 to 20% more than last year. David Farr made a motion to increase the meeting costs to \$45 pre-registered; \$60 at the door and it received a second from Jeff Schardt. The motion passed unanimously.

### ADJOURNMENT

President Allen adjourned the meeting at 1:09 p.m. The next Board meeting will be in Orlando, FL at 10:00 a.m. on Tuesday July 10th , 2001. Directions will be sent in the next board book.

## SCHOLARSHIPS AVAILABLE

The Florida Aquatic Plant Management Society Scholarship And Research Foundation Inc. Announces the availability of the following scholarships.

FAPMS DEPENDENT SCHOLARSHIP– provides up to a \$1,500 scholarship to a deserving dependent of a FAPMS member. The scholarship is based on:

1. The applicant's parent or guardian having been a FAPMS member in good standing for at least three (3) consecutive years.
2. Financial need as determined by the application.
3. The applicant being a high school senior entering college the next academic year, attending junior college or be a college undergraduate.
4. An evaluation of the quality of the application and required essay by the Scholarship Selection committee composed of three FAPMS members and four Scholarship Foundation members.
5. Submission of a completed application by June 15, 2001.

APPLICATOR EDUCATIONAL ASSISTANCE PROGRAM– provides up to fifty percent reimbursement of tuition costs for eligible FAPMS

members who:

1. Work "full time" in the aquatic plant management profession as determined by the FAPMS Scholarship and Research Foundation Board of Directors and are attending college, community college or vocational/technical school to further their educational goals.
2. Have been a FAPMS member in good standing for at least one year.
3. Have paid tuition receipts to submit for reimbursement.
4. Submit a completed application between August 15 and September 15, 2001 for the previous year. The program year will run from August 1 to July 31 of each year.
5. Assistance will be awarded on a pro-rated basis by dividing the amount of funds available by the total amount of eligible tuition costs submitted by all applicants. For example, if the Board approves \$1,000 for the program and \$4,000 of tuition receipts are submitted each applicant would be reimbursed 25% of their tuition costs.
