SCHOLARSHIPS AVAILABLE

The Florida Aquatic Plant Management Society Scholarship And Research Foundation Inc. announces the availability of the following scholarships.

FAPMS DEPENDENT SCHOLARSHIP— provides up to a \$1,500 scholarship to deserving dependents of FAPMS members. The scholarship is based on:

1. The applicant's parent or guardian having been a FAPMS member in good standing for at least three (3) consecutive years.
2. Financial need. Will be determined based on need and the expected family contribution amount indicated on the processing results of a Student Aid Report (OMB No. 1845-0008). This report is available by completing a Free Application for Federal Student Aid Federal Form.
3. The applicant being a high school senior entering college the next academic year, attending junior college or be a college undergraduate.
4. An evaluation of the quality of the application and required essay by the Scholarship Selection committee composed of three FAPMS members and four FAPMS Scholarship and Research Foundation members.
5. Submission of a completed application by June 30, 2002.

WILLIAM L. MAIER JR. SCHOLARSHIP— provides up to \$1,000 to a deserving student who is :

1. Enrolled in an accredited Florida University or College.
2. A U.S. citizen.

I. CALL TO ORDER

President Rodgers called the meeting to order at 10:00 a.m.

II. ROLL CALL AND MINUTES

Todd Olson took the roll and President Rodgers declared a quorum. President Rodgers asked if anyone had any deletions, omissions, or modifications to the minutes of the first quarter 2002 Board of Director's meeting. A motion was made to accept the minutes for the first quarter 2002 Board of Directors' Meeting and it passed unanimously.

III. CORRESPONDENCE

President Rodgers mentioned a letter written by Ken Gioeli (IFAS extension agent) to FAPMS board member Jim Cuda requesting \$150 sponsorship for the Florida Association of Natural Resources Extension Professional's (FANREP) annual conference and awards. P.J. Myers made a motion to send the \$150 sponsorship; it received a second from Todd Olson and passed unanimously. President Rodgers mentioned a letter he wrote to Bill Opp (Lee County Hyacinth Control District) thanking him for

the invitation to host the 2002 FAPMS meeting in Fort Myers. The last piece of correspondence was a letter from APMS Scholastic Endowment Committee Chair Tyler Koschnick. Tyler thanked FAPMS for their sponsorship to the Educational Outreach Program for printing the fifth grade curriculum "Understanding Invasive Aquatic Weeds."

IV. TREASURER'S REPORT-Rebecca Gubert

Rebecca reported that the draft balance sheet ending March 31, 2002 showed that the Society's current assets were \$34,141.93 and liabilities at \$0.00. A breakdown of the total assets included a Nations Bank checking balance of \$1,902.28, and a Nations Bank savings account balance of \$5,858.73, Nations Bank CD account balance of approximately \$10,066.63, \$13,078.70 in the Strong Money Market Fund, and \$3,235.59 in inventory.

Steve Green presented two potential by-law changes to clarify that the past president is or is not an officer and officer/director terms. Vicki Pontius made a motion to accept the by-laws committee wording and send the before mentioned proposed by-law changes to the general membership to be voted on at the FAPMS Annual Training Conference at Daytona

Beach in November. Mike Baker seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

5. Financial—John Rodgers

President Rodgers had no report.

6. Government Affairs—John Rodgers

President Rodgers summarized the potential "Muck removal rule" for the board.

7. Historical—Robbie Lovestrand

8. Local Arrangements—Bill Torres

IX. NEW BUSINESS

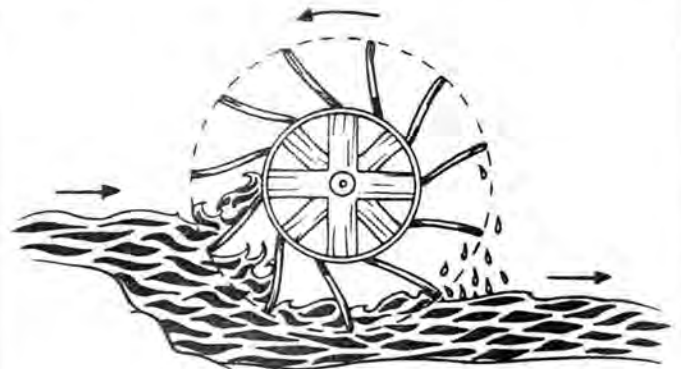
There was no new business.

Summary of Rule Changes Affecting Pesticide Applicators

The following changes have been made to CEU requirements:

Aquatic Category—Beginning January 1, 2000, licensed applicators are required to have 16 continuing education units (CEUs) to renew the aquatic category. At least 8 of the 16 CEUs must be approved for the aquatic category, and at least 2 of the 16 CEUs must be approved for Core (general standards). The remaining 6 CEUs may be approved for either Core or the aquatic category.

Requirement for Core CEUs—Beginning January 1, 2000, all applicators must earn at least 2 different Core CEUs for each category in which licensed. The same Core CEUs cannot count for multiple categories. For example: An applicator licensed in 3 categories must earn at least 6 Core CEUs to renew with CEUs.

Reminder: Renewing by Exam

All applicators have an option of taking the exams again to renew their license instead of earning CEUs. For applicators with more than one category, some categories may be renewed with CEUs and other

categories by exam. If renewing by exam, the applicator must take the Core exam plus category exams. If the applicator has earned at least 4 Core CEUs, it is not necessary to take the Core exam for renewal.

CEUs can be attained by attending FLDACS approved seminars, county extension training sessions, or by in home training materials. The phone number to inquire or order training materials is (850) 488-3314 or visit them on the web at www.ifas.ufl.edu/~ent1/software/FL-ceu.htm.

Core CEUs

Effective January 1, 2005, all applicators licensed under Chapter 487, F.S., who renew their licenses using Continuing Education Units (CEUs) will be required to have 4 core CEUs in addition to the number of category CEUs now required. At that time, all category CEUs must be approved for the specific category. There will no longer be a requirement for having 2 core CEUs per primary category, and core CEUs will no longer apply to the required number of category CEUs. Applicators will have the option of retaking the core and/or category exams if they do not have enough CEUs for renewal.

Editor's Note: The license fees have increased to \$60 for private and public applicators, and to \$160 for commercial applicators. The license is still valid for four years.

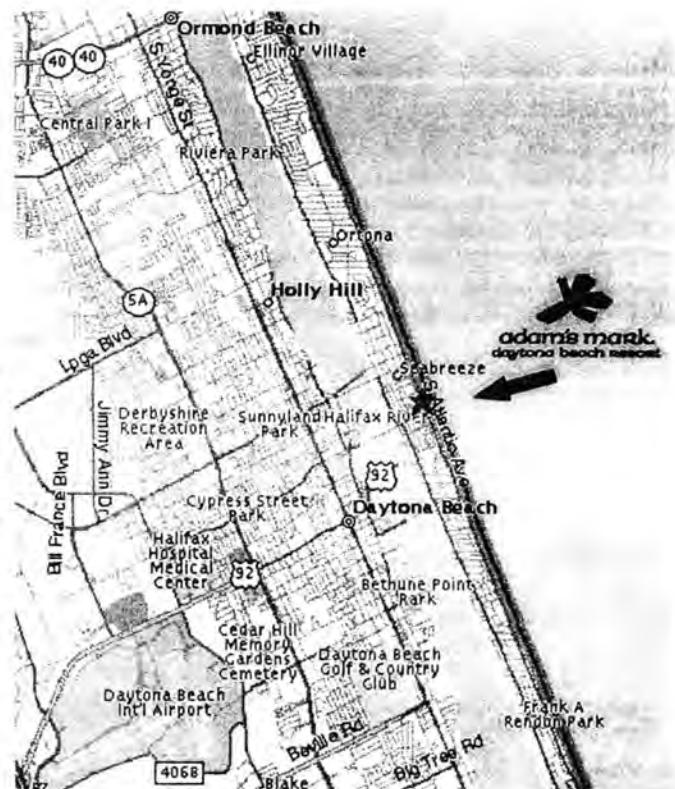

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
