The first President's Award was presented to **Bill Moore** in recognition to the many contributions made to the Florida Aquatic Plant Management Society. October 2007

Bill Moore:

Although Bill claims he is retired, we all know that Bill has been and continues to play a very important role in our Society. At this time, he is the Past President of FAPMS and works just as hard in his so-called retirement as he did when he was receiving a paycheck for his efforts. Before Bill came into our industry, he was an active member of the Army for 5 years. While enlisted, he earned a Bronze Star and the Army Commendation Medal and as a reservist earned the Meritorious Service Medal. After leaving the Army, Bill began his career in our industry, spending 5 years as a distributor rep and 30 years as a manufacturer's rep. During that time, he held many titles. Bill was a marketing entomologist, an aquatic biologist, aquatic specialist, assistant operations manager, branch manager, and finally a sales representative. He worked for the companies Pennwalt, Zoecon Corporation, Helena Chemical Company and retired as Senior Sales Rep. at Cerexagri on June 1, 2005.

Mike Page;

Mike Page has been a major contributor to the development of aerial application programs that are used throughout our industry. Mike is part owner of Helicopter Applicators, Inc. and as a pilot brings more than 34 years and over 11,000 flight hours conducting aquatic herbicide applications, rights-of-way spraying, control of the gypsy moth, black fly and mosquito, and fire ignition and suppression.

Mike has worked throughout the state of Florida on many public lands. He has assisted with the development of many programs that have become part of the "toolbox" for fighting invasives. He has been instrumental in the development of best management practices for the control of invasives such as Old World Climbing Fern, melalueca, and torpedo grass. As for bio-control, Mike has provided inoculation services for the harvesting, transportation, and deposition of southern naiad in the filter marshes of the Everglades restoration project. Mr. Page, along with his company, Helicopter Applicators, helped with the design and construction of the thru valve boom and the 1000-pound tote which have revolutionized and streamlined aerial applications. He developed a granular loading system that greatly reduces labor requirements and eliminates potential exposure for workers on the ground. He also assisted with and continues development of various innovative nozzle configurations for specific applications. Mr. Page has conducted numerous aerial research plots for SFWMD, Everglades National Park, USDA, U of F, and various chemical companies. Many of these studies have resulted in the development of integrated pest management protocols and specific aerial application guidelines. Mr. Page maintains a very high standard of quality by assuring that all equipment is properly maintained and all personnel are fully trained and experienced. End results of his standards are always excellent.

2008 Scholarship Award

The South Carolina Aquatic Plant Management Society is seeking applications for its annual Phillip M. Fields Scholarship Award. The Society intends to award a \$3,000 scholarship to the successful applicant in the fall of 2008. Scholarship funds may be used by the recipient to cover costs associated with education and research expenses. Eligible applicants must be enrolled as full time undergraduate or graduate students in an accredited college or university in the United States. Course work or research in an area related to the biology, ecology or management of aquatic plants in the Southeast is also required.

Applications must be received no later than May 1, 2008 and will be evaluated on the basis of relevant test scores (ACT, SAT, GRE, etc.), high school and/or college grades, quality and relevance of course work or research, a proposed budget, information obtained from references, and other related considerations. Other factors being equal, preference will be given to applicants enrolled in Southeastern and South Carolina academic institutions. The successful applicant may be requested to present an oral report on research activities at the annual meeting of the Society. Application forms and additional information are available at:






