# Paul C. Myers Applicator Dependent Scholarship

The Paul C. Myers Applicator Dependent Scholarship-Provides up to \$1500 to deserving dependents of FAPMS members. The scholarship is based on:

- 1. The applicant's parent or guardian having been a FAPMS member in good standing for at least three consecutive years.
- Financial need. Will be determined based on need and the expected family contribution amount indicated on the processing results of a Student Aid Report (OMB No. 1845-0008). This report is available by completing a Free Application for Federal Student Aid Federal Form.
- 3. The applicant being a high school senior entering college the next academic year, attending junior college, or being a college undergraduate.
- An evaluation of the quality of the application and required essay by the the scholarship selection committee composed of three FAPMS members and four FAPMS Scholarship and Research Foundation members.
- 5. Submission of a completed Application Form by the closing date.

# **Proposed By Law Change**

## Section 1. There shall be five four classes of Society membership.

### Part 1. Active Membership:

A resident of Florida who is Persons who are involved in operation, sales, consulting, research, regulation, education, or participation in programs relative to aquatic plant management in Florida shall become an active member of this Society upon payment of dues. This member may vote, hold office, and enjoy all privileges of Society membership.

## Part 2. Associate Membership:

This class of membership may be held by persons who are not residents of Florida, but otherwise are qualified as in Part 1 of this section. Dues will be the same as for active membership. Associate members shall receive all publications of the Society, may serve on committees, but may not vote or hold office.

## Part 3 2. Student Membership:

Student members shall be those individuals actively enrolled in full time college level study of aquatic weeds, or related types of college level studies approved by the Board of Directors. Privileges and limitations shall be the same as of Associate members.

### Part 4 3. Honorary Lifetime Membership:

Any active member who has provided extraordinary support and assistance toward accomplishing the goals and objectives of the society. Honorary membership may be granted by majority approval of the board of directors and no dues are required. This member may vote, hold office, and enjoy all privileges of Society membership.

### Part 5 4. Library Membership:

A Library Membership shall be required for any library institution wishing to receive all publications of the Society. Library Members may not vote or hold office.

# Call For Papers - FAPMS 2014 Meeting

The FAPMS 38th Annual Training Conference will be held October 13-16, 2014 at the Daytona Beach Hilton in Daytona Beach, FL. We are looking for papers on herbicide application and mechanical techniques (aquatic, natural area and right-of-way), mixtures, innovative control measures, re-vegetation projects, new exotic plant introductions, research projects, etc. We welcome talks from researchers, scientists, applicators and other field personnel – in short, anyone involved in aquatics! You don't have to be a professional speaker in order to present a paper! Remember, FAPMS was formed for the aquatic plant manager and the annual training conference is a chance to share what you have learned with other members. Each year the Society awards all field personnel who present a paper with a plaque. This year the top three applicator papers will receive a plaque and cash awards. First place will receive \$300, second place will receive \$200, and third place will receive \$100. In addition to these prizes, the first seven applicators to sign up and give a paper will receive an additional \$100 (for participating).
