

I have compiled instructions for the next editor and could help them take over. I suggest that the board considers switching to two issues per year – a Spring/Summer issue and Fall/Winter issue. You'd lose some ad income but it would be a lot easier on the editor and Angie (advertisers) to do two issues instead of 3 or 4. Just a thought.

Lyn Gettys as Ad Hoc Editor will continue to work for 4 issues and asked the board to please assist with collecting content. Lyn also suggested to continue to search for a full time Editor. Jennifer Myers suggested sending out a survey to the membership to see which topics they would like to see in Aquatics magazine.
